Apply what you've already done and the techniques that you have learned to the project of YOUR CHOICE!

You may use something you've already created like your mandala design, a favorite technique, or enlarge/adapt a page from your altered book or timeline.

Brainstorm:

- --Who is your client? Who are you trying to sell to?
- -- Create a design for something you would use.
- --Start with a favorite technique and imagine where it could be applied.
- --Improve a design already out there
- --work to be displayed for Fine Art extravaganza

Requirements:

- 1. Use of design strategies. (grab an image, visual dictionary, technique from book or online tutorial) Show me in your sketchbook a minimum of three ideas or variations on one idea. Write down all sources (book titles,urls).
- 2. Self-learning and collaboration. This is your final--I strongly encourage you to be independent and collaborative. These are the skills you will need in life so start practicing now!
- 3. Effective use of the elements and principles of design
- 4. Use what you've learned and experienced in this class. I am looking for progress. You should approach your art differently than you did at the beginning of this term.
